It is to inform that the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) reviewed the Assessor's Report dated 30.06.2022 regarding faculty, their experience, publication and other teaching facilities including infrastructure available at Konaseema Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Foundation, Amalapuram under NTR University of Health Sciences, VijayWada in the State of Andhra Pradesh for increase of seats in MD (DVL) for the academic year 2022-23.

The Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) has made the following decision:

APPROVED FOR 2 SEATS (Two to Four) MD (DVL)

The Commission has decided to obtain undertaking/ essential document for issue of Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MD (DVL) with annual intake of 04 seats for the academic year 2022-23:-

1. The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings, equipment and hospital facilities as per National Medical Commission norms.

- 2. No student should be admitted in the above courses till the formal permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB).
- 3. The Private Medical College should Provide Bank Guarantee of required amount against increase of **2** (two) seats in favour of National Medical Commission, New Delhi valid for three years or till the course is recognised, whichever is later, from a nationalized/ scheduled Bank as per NMC/MCl's norms. However, medical colleges/institutions governed by the State Govt. are required to furnish only an undertaking signed by Govt. Authority to provide funds in their budget till the facilities are fully provided as per time bound programme indicated by them.
- 4. The Medical Colleges/ institutions will provide undertaking to implement the decision regarding payment of stipend to the PG students similar to PG students of Govt. Medical Colleges in their State.
- The Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) reserve the right to withdraw/cancel/revoke
 the Letter of Intent/ Letter of Permission if it comes to the notice that the permission has been
 obtained from Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) by misrepresentation of fact or
 fraud.

It shall be incumbent upon the Medical College that the information relating to admission should be submitted within the time specified in the circular in this regards issued by this office from time to time. Any failure to submit the information within this time limit would be construed that the admission in the College were not in accordance with the statutory requirements, thereby enabling the Commission to proceed in accordance with law against the college.

Action to grant formal permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) for increase in intake/starting of the said course at your college will be initiated on receipt of appropriate bank guarantee, if applicable and undertaking/ compliance letter fulfilling the conditions enumerated above.

The acceptance letter may be sent within **1** (one) week from the date of issue of this letter to enable the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB) to issue Letter of Permission for the academic year 2022-23.
