- (iv) The applicant should provide a Bank Guarantee of Rs.9.50Crores (Rupees 2.00 Crores towards medical college an 7.50 crores towards hospital facilities) valid for five years from a nationalized/ scheduled Bank as per the norms of the Medical Council of India.

4. Action to grant formal permission of the Central Govt. for starting of a new medical college at Amalapuram by your Society will be initiated on receipt of a compliance letter fulfilling the conditions enumerated in the paragraph 3 above.

The next batch of students shall not be admitted unless renewal of permission is granted by the Central Government.

3. This permission is subject to the Bank Guarantees of Rs. 9.50 crores (2.00 crores towards medical college and Rs. 7.50 crores for hospital facilities) valid for five years furnished by Mother Theresa Educational Society Amlapuram for the establishment of medical college and hospital found to be adequate/genuine on all counts. The admission process for the academic year 2005-06 has to be completed in accordance with the time schedule indicated in the Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997, as amended.

Sir/ Madam,

I am directed to inform that the compliance verification assessment of the physical and the other teaching facilities available for continuance of recognition of MBBS degree granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Konaseema Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Foundation, Amalapuram was carried out by the Council Assessors on 3.5.2016. The compliance verification assessment report (3.5.2016) along with the previous assessment reports (2.2.2016 & 10<sup>th</sup>& 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2015) was considered by the Executive Committee at its meeting held on 13.05.2016. The following recommendations of the Executive Committee was approved by the General Body of the Council at its meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> November, 2016:-

*"The Executive Committee of the Council considered the compliance verification assessment report (3.5.2016) along with the previous assessment reports (2.2.2016 & 10<sup>th</sup>& 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2015) and decided to recommend that recognition of MBBS degree granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Konaseema Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Foundation, Amalapuram be continued restricting the number of admission to 150 (One Hundred fifty) students.*

*The Executive Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Sections 8(3)(2), 8(3)(3) & 8(3)(4) of the Establishment of Medical Colleges Regulations (Amendment), 2010 (Part II) dated 16<sup>th</sup> April 2010 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-*

*8 (3) ...*

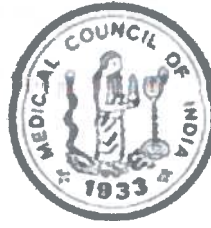
*(2) The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of MBBS degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.*

*(3) The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.*

*(4) Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute."*

The above decision of the General Body has been approved by the Oversight Committee on 28.04.2017.
