Subject: Establishment of new medical college in the name and style of "Konaseema Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Foundation" at Amalapuram, Andhra Pradesh- Permission of the Central Govt. Regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your proposal on the subject mentioned above, seeking permission of the Central Govt. to start a new medical college in the name and style of "Konaseema Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Foundation" at Amalapuram,., by Mother Theresa Educational Society, Amalapuram under Section 10 (A) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956, as amended and to say that your proposal was referred to the Medical council of India for its evaluation and recommendation.

2. After careful consideration of the scheme and taking into consideration the recommendations of Medical Council of India in this regard, this Ministry have come to a conclusion that the letter of intent for establishment of a new medical college at Amalapuram by Mother Theresa Educational Society with an annual intake of 150 (One Hundred fifty) students with prospective effect under Section 10 (A) of IMC Act may be issued.

Hence this letter of Intent.

3. This letter of intent is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- (i) The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings, equipments and hospital facilities as per Medical Council of India norms.
- (ii) Other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report should be rectified. A copy of inspection report is enclosed.
- (iii) No student should be admitted in the above college till the formal permission of Central Govt. is granted.
- (iv) The applicant should provide a Bank Guarantee of Rs.9.50Crores (Rupees 2.00 Crores towards medical college an 7.50 crores towards hospital facilities) valid for five years from a nationalized/ scheduled Bank as per the norms of the Medical Council of India.

4. Action to grant formal permission of the Central Govt. for starting of a new medical college at Amalapuram by your Society will be initiated on receipt of a compliance letter fulfilling the conditions enumerated in the paragraph 3 above.
